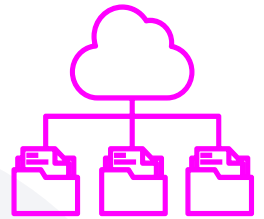
WHAT MULTI-CLOUD MEANS
